Since November of 2019, the pandemic has kept away for two years away from our beloved Bo Ai School. Thanks to zoom and weChat I am kept abreast and posted on the happennings and matters at the School. However being not personally present at the School keeps me out of the sights and sound and instant feelings This missive would therefore not be totally a reportage of the mindset and sentiments of the moment.



First of all, we thank you all for remembering and supporting our school. Thanks also for your faithful prayers. The Corona-19 virus has modified the education process at our school. Presently, **daily temperature taking is routine**. **Classes ae held without masks**. But in any contact with visitors, masks are required. **For parents** touching our school grounds, **masks are required absolutely**.

We ae mindful and honored by the 14 teams from the Xinyuan County and beyond that paid visits to Bo Ai in 2020 and again 14 teams in 2021. They were teams from the County Education Department, Safety Department, County Building Department, Sunshine Sports Committee, Women's Group, Township Antidrug Brigade and others. We must never forget Bo Ai's **Annual Carnival Event**, which was held on April 29. **Thanks to Michael and Janet Tse** who have been supporting **this coveted event** all these years. There were games galore. As usual, the kids **earn points** during the year to play the games and the **won points** at the carnival **translate into prizes**. The kids love the **Popcorn, Cotton Candy and Sausages**. **Every Wednesday our Loving Heart Black Belt Master Zhang** drives **all the way from Zhangzhi**, a **round trip of three hours** on a **voluntary basis** and **gives Taikwando lessons** to our Middle Schoolers. We just love her. Rain or shine. Bless her soul. **She has been doing this for 5 years**.



The Yau Foundation held its annual basketball competition in July and Bo Ai joined in the competition with the County Schools. Children's Day on June 1st was a big affair. The entire school lined up at the School Quadrangle. The School gave out Certificates and recognized the achievements of the students in various categories. What's more: George Tsang of Vancouver, B.C. bought Chicken Drumsticks for the entire school and staff. Thanks also to Lydia Yiu of Zhongshan who bought and sent food stuff to our school several times. On October 29, Bo Ai held its Annual Choir Presentation and Competition. Because of the Covid, parents were not invited to attend.

For the **last two years**, I was **not able to attend** the **Graduation Ceremonies** of the Kindergarten, Elementary and the Middle Schoolers and **not able to congratulate** the graduates in person. **This is heart-rending**. But thanks to the **OHH Houston Group for gifts of books to the graduates every year**.

Every two weeks on a rotation basis, our Bo Ai **sends a Middle Schoolers team to the Old Folks Home** to sing to them, dance before them, cut their nails or hair or just talk to them. Since **every Thanksgiving time BoAi raise funds** to buy some food stuff or needed small gifts for the old folks. These old folk are **all male** who have **never gotten married or have a family**.

Our Elementary School Building and our Boy's Dormitory are seventeen years old. The single pane windows do not shield the classrooms or dorm rooms from the biting cold in the winters. Our thanks to Touching Lives Overseas of Canada and to the Hong Kong Bo Ai Foundation for the remodeling and installation of double pane windows and repair of the radiator heating pipes.. Thanks to these two organizations for their generosity and loving hearts in financing the remodeling and repair work and purchasing some needed kitchenwares.

There are changes from the Central Government directed at private schools. So far we have not been informed how this would affect Bo Ai School, a non profit school. .



In this missive, I try to give you an overview of the progress we have made. a snapshot of where we have been and how we look with confidence and hope for the future. Yet, many students remain to be sponsored. Our Dining Hall and Kitchen is substandard and need to be extended towards the Elementary Education Building side and constructed. The Kitchen Equipment is sixteen years old and some need to be replaced. For so many years, we have been trying to build the Sports Running Tract and Soccer Field behind the Middle School to qualify as a Middle School. Bo Ai needs to convince our 6th Grade students to stay on and continue their Middle School Education at Bo Ai. Our goal is to increase our Middle School Enrollment. Our teachers and Principals need more continuing education to update themselves on the new developments in education.

With our feet firmly rooted in Fengcun, Shanxi and bolstered by your prayers and support, we look to the future with confidence and hope. Bo Ai is Not Just for Education but For Life. Bo Ai endeavors to instill a sound moral character, academic excellence and care for others within our students. May the Good Lord Bless You and Your Love Ones with Joy, Hope and Good Health.
